
Protecting the Sources of Our Drinking Water Through Collaborative Partnerships

Forest Management



Through Public/Private Partnership, the US Forest Service is actively addressing fire mitigation projects within the Middle Truckee River Watershed to help protect water quality of the region's primary source of drinking water.



The Integrated Source Water **Protection Plan for Washoe County** is a multi-agency effort that engages with new businesses, providing information about protection of source water with guidelines on how

to prevent or report contamination.

The Truckee River Fund (TRF) focuses on supporting projects that protect water quality and river resources.

Established by Truckee Meadows Water Authority, over 175 qualified projects have received \$15 million from the TRF, resulting in match funding of over \$23 million since 2004.

The One Truckee River Partnership **Council** has 22 active partners united to protect water quality of the Truckee River within the the Reno/Sparks corridor- from public restrooms along the river recreational path to pollutant reductions through coordinated vegetation management.
